The Department of Citywide Administrative Services (DCAS) is in receipt of a June 5, 2017 letter from Alyssa Cobb Konon of the Department of Parks & Recreation (PARKS) and a June 19, 2017 letter from Andrew Schwartz of the Department of Small Business Services (DSBS) regarding PARKS surrender of the above referenced properties for assignment to DSBS for development of the site.

The parcels requested include land only eastward of the Oak Point Rail Link trestle. PARKS will be notified to consider reassignment of the Pier 5 area should the site not receive the required land use approvals to facilitate redevelopment.
