RESOLVED That the Design Commission, having considered designs for the rehabilitation of the Jerome Park Reservoir, Goulden Avenue, Sedgwick Avenue, and Reservoir Avenue, Bronx, submitted by the Department of Environmental Protection, represented by exhibits 1537-BG, BH, BI & BJ of record in this matter, hereby gives to the same unanimous preliminary and final approval with the understanding that, after the shutdown of the Delaware Aqueduct is complete, DEP will reevaluate the feasibility of the removal of the buttress wall and repair and repointing of the east basin wall.

Final approval is conditioned upon commencement of work before February 13, 2020, and submission of comprehensive photographic documentation of the completed project consisting of 8" x 10" archival-quality color photographs.
